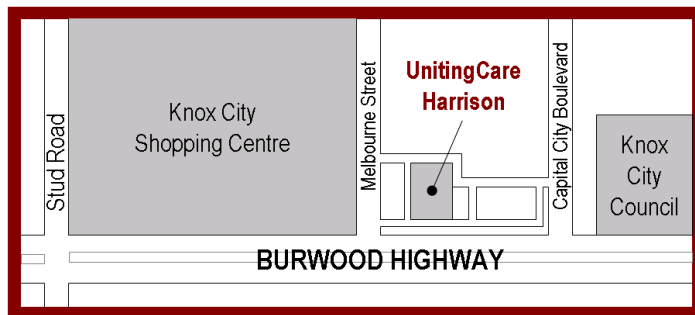

Options For Families

If you are a family living in the Eastern Metropolitan area of Melbourne, live in or have lived in an unregistered or substandard rooming house we can support you to successfully establish and maintain long term housing, preventing you from re-entering the homelessness service system.

We will work with families to ensure:

- Intensive support is provided to access, establish and maintain long term, secure & affordable housing
- Links to the community are provided including financial counselling, employment, education and training support.
- Children in homeless families are given support to engage in education and community recreation.
- Pathways are improved to access long term housing for families.

Support vacancies

Vacancies will be listed on the Opening Door resource register under the Transitional Support category. The referrals are to come through Harrison's Opening Door Service using the regional CHART.
